Climate change



- Global warming **is a reality** that has accelerated in recent decades

Over-exploitation of resources



- From 1970, the annual global extraction of materials tripled and it continues to grow

Biodiversity



- Severe ecosystem degradation (40% marine - 75% terrestrial)
- One million species at risk

Pollution

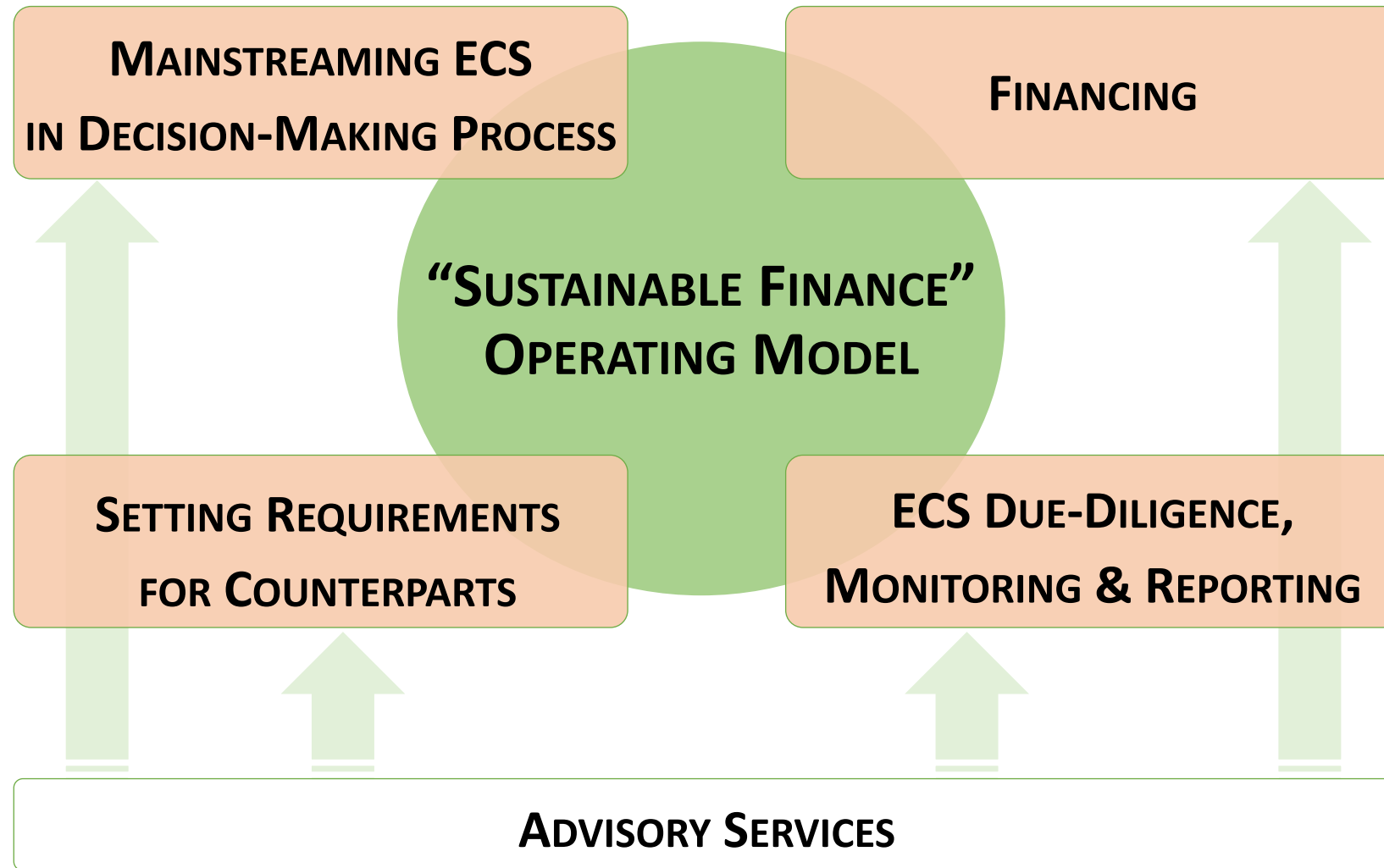


- Annual waste generation will increase by 70% by 2050
- Only 12% of the materials used in the EU industry comes from recycling

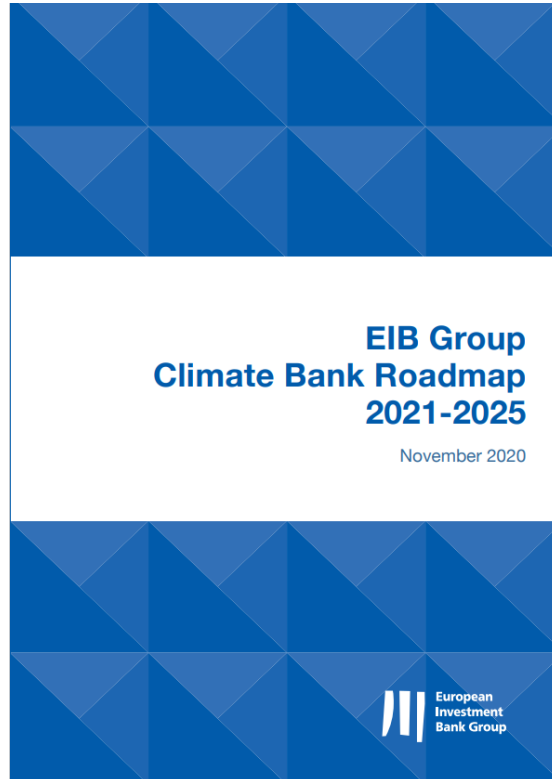

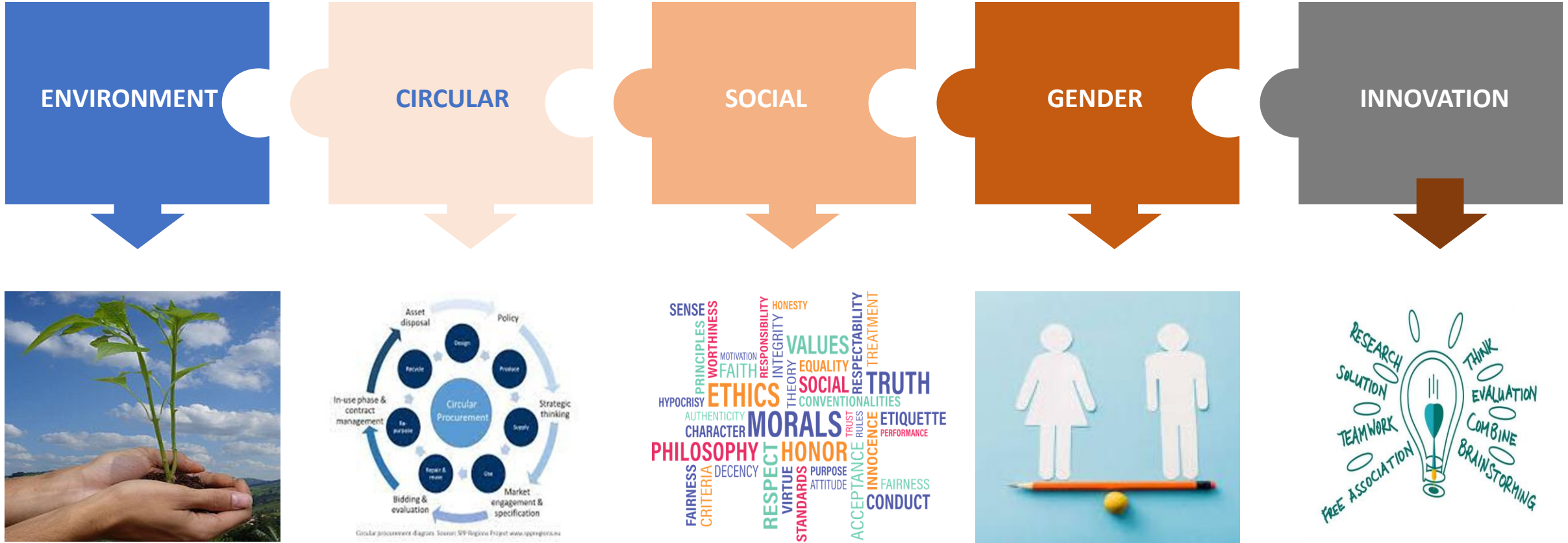

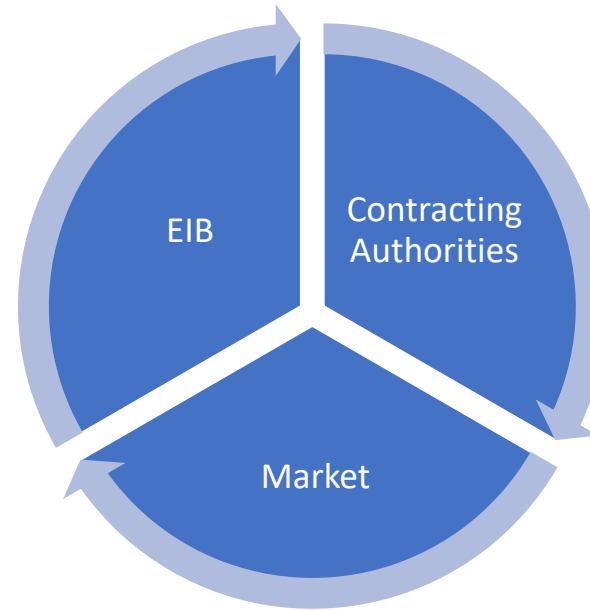
