# What is considered “green”? (I)



Criteria as defined by MoEnv for 18 product groups

Products that have I type Ecolables, such as *EU Ecolabel*, *Nordic Swan*, *Blue Angel* and etc.

When purchasing services, the environmental management systems that are ISO 14001 certified or EMAS are applicable, if they fulfil environmental objectives for the services that are being purchased.

## What is considered “green”? (II)



Environment friendly product, which is in orientational list 2015 m. November 24 d. (EU) 2015/2174

Innovation which improves or substitutes existing solution with more environment friendly solution

Intellectual (non-material) services

## What is considered “green”? (III)



### Independent environmental criteria by Purchasing Organizations based on the 5 environmental principles

Circularity – use second-hand and recycled material

Energy efficiency – low energy consumption or renewable energy use

Toxic substances – reduced toxic substances in products

Durability – the product is durable, functional and easily fixed or reused

Reuse – the product can be recycled or easily reused

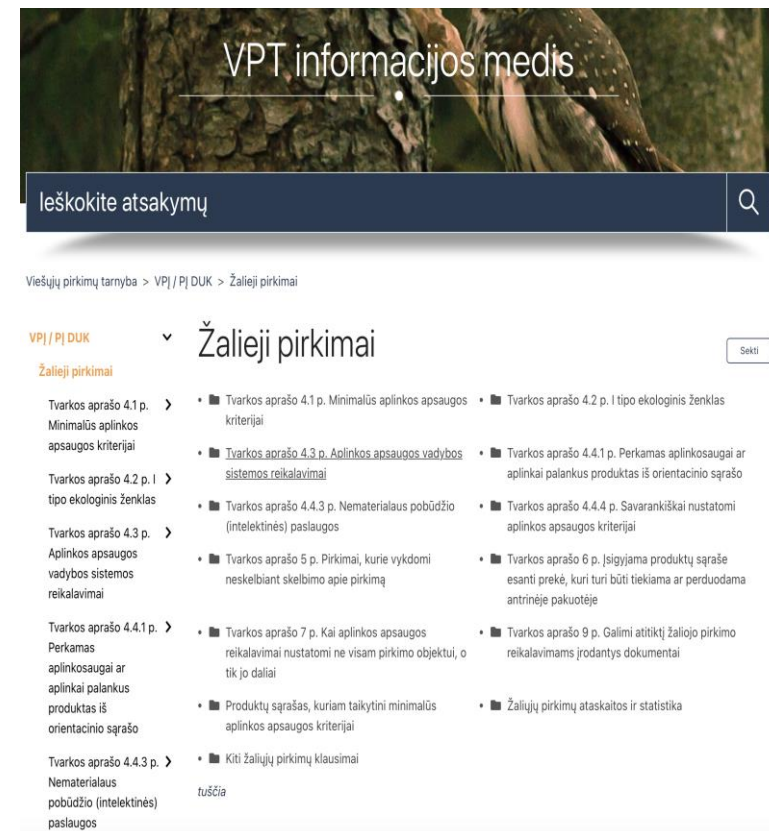

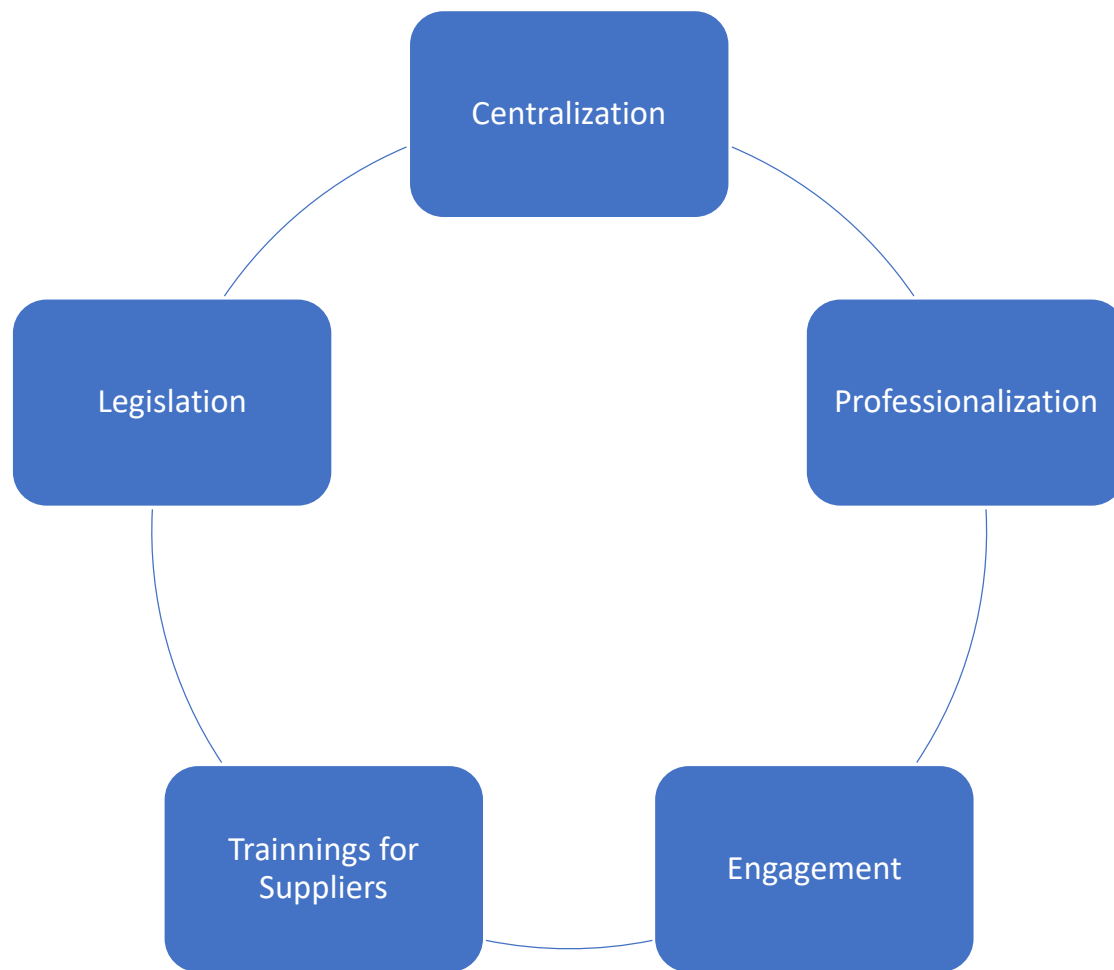

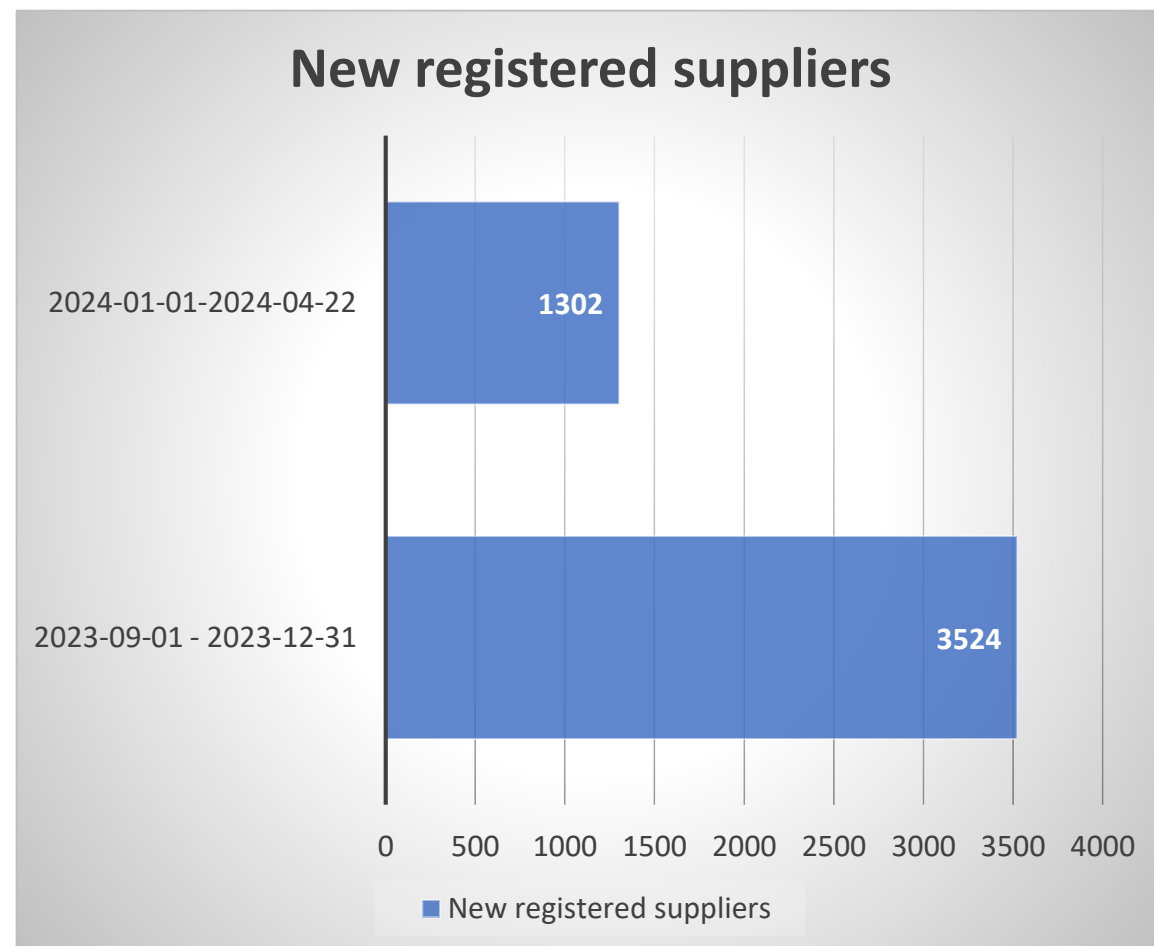
